Midterm Schedule

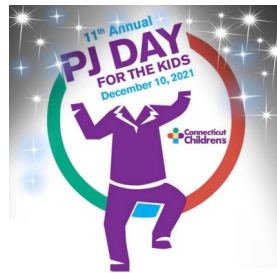
The month of December means that Midterms at MSMHS are just around the corner! Midterm exams will begin on Thursday, December 16th and run through Wednesday, December 22nd with make-ups or snow days scheduled for Thursday, December 23rd. The Wednesday before exams is an A Day and will be a review for Block 1, 2, 3 and 4 exams. Monday, December 20th is also a full B Day and will be a review for Block 5, 6, 7 and 8 exams. Students are not permitted to take exams early and if a student misses a day of exams they will need to report on the exam make up day or take the exam after the break. Our goal in having midterms in December is to allow all students and teachers to have a shut-off during break. The first exam of the day runs from 7:30-9:30am and the second exam runs from 9:50-11:50am. The cafeteria will be open in the morning for breakfast and will be serving a snack during the 20 minute break in between exams. Breakfast and snack are provided free for all students. 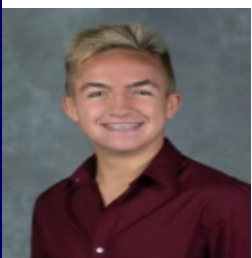
Pay \$1 to Wear Your PJs!
